A new season is starting for Oregon Camellia Society. For our first meeting, we will be attending a tea workshop in Vancouver put on by Minto Island Tea Company. After the workshop, we can lunch (byo) and hold a business meeting in Pacific Park if needed. The announcement for the event is as follows:

Oregon's fertile Willamette Valley nurtures not only wine grapes and hops for beer, but also Camellia sinensis, the tea plant. Join Elizabeth Miller and Chris Jenkins, owners of Minto Island Tea Company, for a presentation and discussion on the cultivation of Camellia sinensis in the Pacific Northwest. The presentation will focus on methods of propagation, planting and establishing C. sinensis, and how to pick and process your own tea.

The presenters will have tea samples on hand for taking home and plants available for sale at \$15 each (4" pots, 12 - 18" tall).
